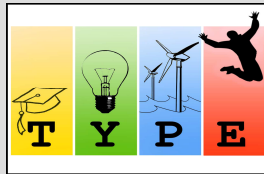

26th – 27th June 2012, Brussels

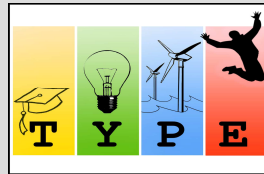

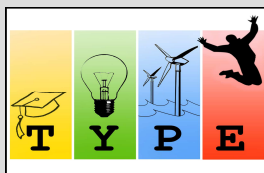
