With only 12 years old a teenager can have 50% of their teeth at risk.

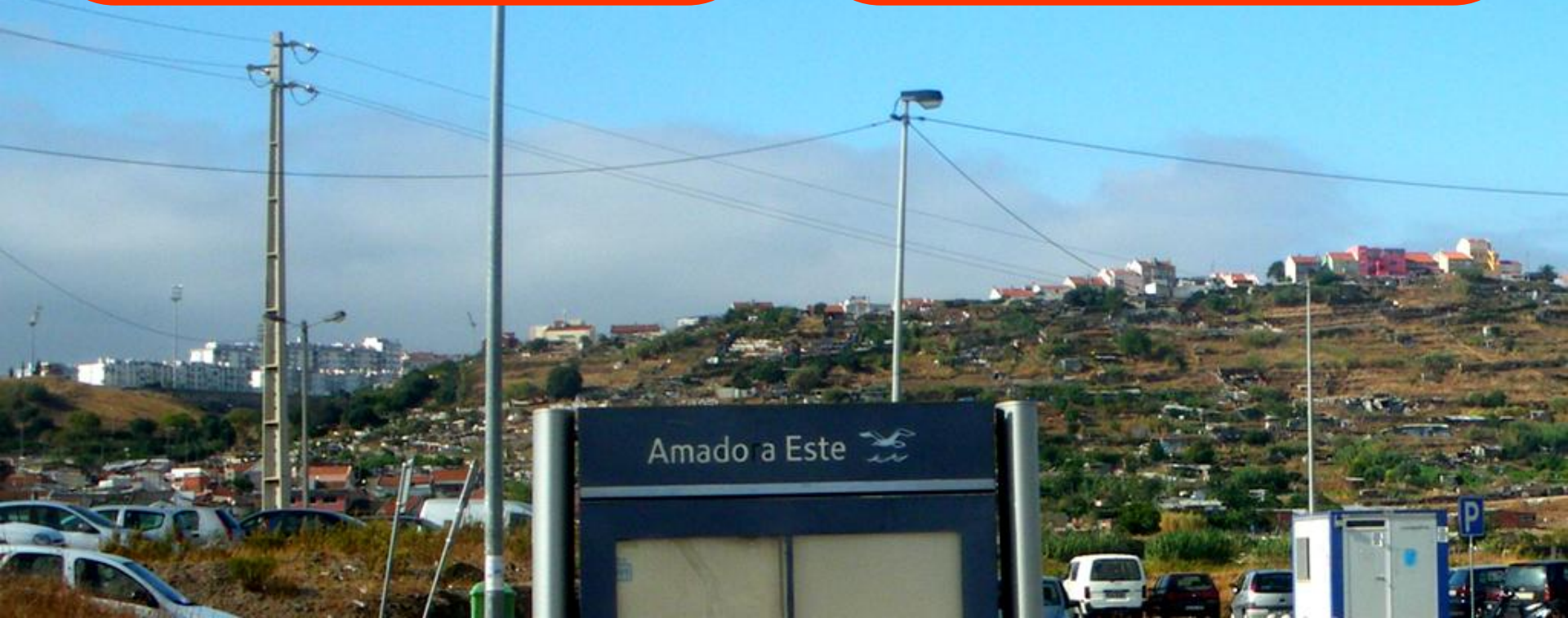

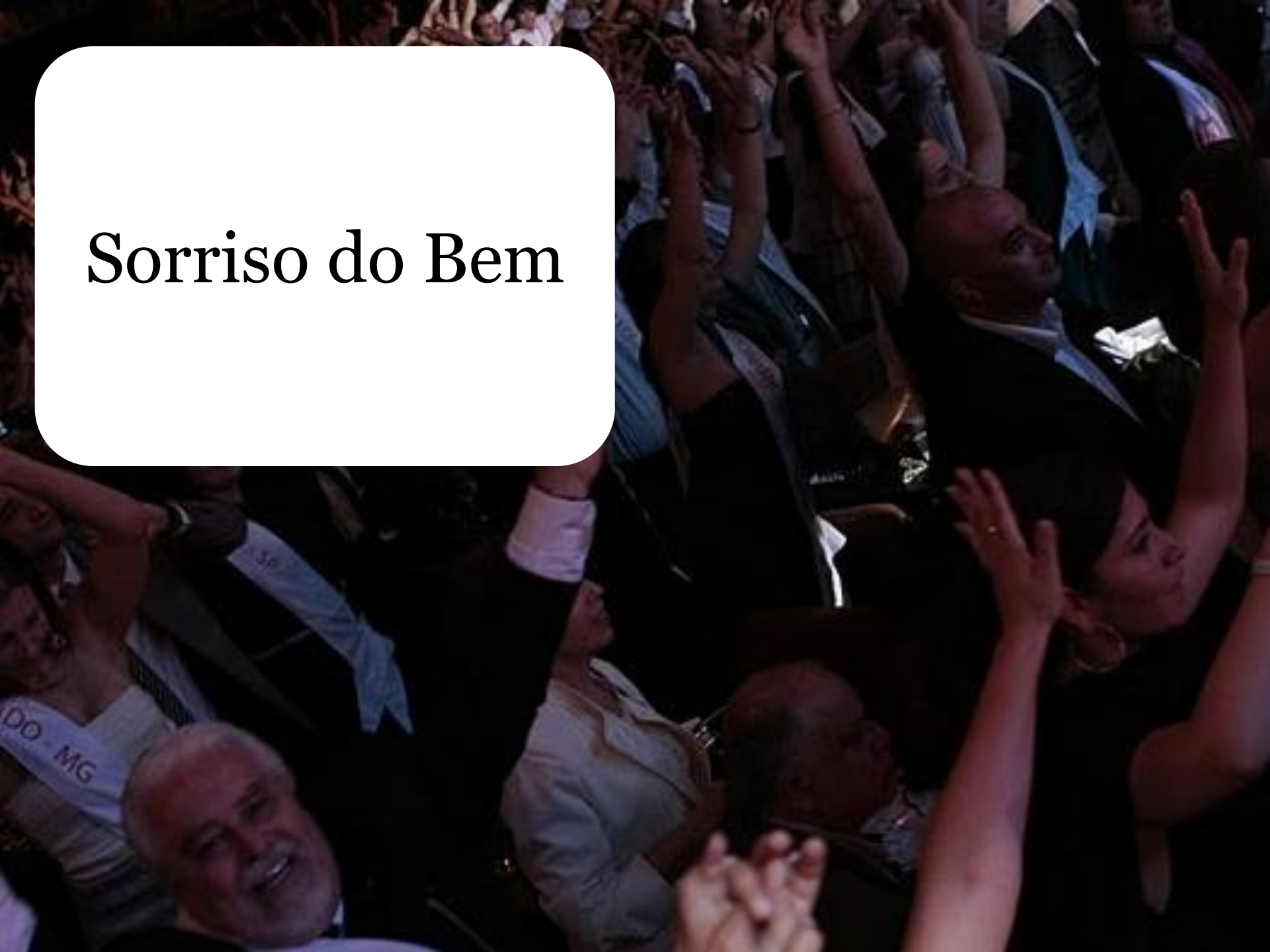
1. Seguir as normas da Vigilância Sanitária local.
