Was elected a MP of the Slovak Parliament immediately after the revolution in 1989.

He later served as a department director at the Federal Ministry for Environment in Prague and advisor to the minister. After the split of Czechoslovakia he worked as director of the Ekopolis Foundation supporting programs focusing on environment, community development, philanthropy, civil and human rights, gender equity, strengthening democracy and civil society. He also served on a large number of non-profit boards at home and internationally. He initiated Global Fund for Community Foundations in 2004. Dr. Mesik was awarded the Eisenhower Exchange Fellowship in Philadelphia, the Salzburg Seminar Fellowship and Synergos Senior Fellowship in Global Philanthropy based in New York. Dr. Mesik is author of numerous commentaries and analytical articles published mostly in Slovak opinion making media. He also served on the steering committee for the OK 98 campaign for free and fair national election in 1998 and up to 2014 on the board of European Environmental Bureau in Brussels.
